Behaviour Management Policy Statement

Children develop at their own rates, and in their own ways. All children are unique and we believe this is the key to understanding children's behaviour.

Poulton St Chad's Nursery supports children's behaviour by providing the following:

- A Behaviour Management policy and procedure which is followed by all who come into contact with children in our setting.
- A named practitioner responsible for Behaviour Management in every setting. This practitioner will have the necessary skills to advise other staff on behaviour issues and will access expert advice where necessary.
- A code of conduct outlining our expectations of staff in line with the EYFS safeguarding and welfare requirements, which states that corporal punishment will not be used.
